Renowned tapestry weaver Jennifer Sharpe will travel to East Gippsland in August and over ten workshop days create a tapestry with members from the community based on a gridded map of East Gippsland. Jennifer has been weaving for over 30 years including 6 years teaching at the Australian Tapestry Workshop. Tapestry weaving is a weft faced weave which is woven on upright looms, an ancient method but very meditative. Jennifer will teach the basic techniques and participants can be a part of the project while learning a new skill.

The finished Love East Gippsland Community Tapestry will remain in East Gippsland and over time will be on display at various venues throughout East Gippsland.
